

# Glass Fusing and Slumping class- 4<sup>th</sup> / 5<sup>th</sup> grades

Tuesdays 2:50-3:50pm September 21- Nov 9th 2010

In this 8 week class the students will explore the ancient art form of glass fusing and slumping. We will learn to cut glass and by laying colors over clear glass will create our designs. This is then kiln fired to about 1400 degree to fuse the pieces together.

The class will incorporate discussions about design, art, expectations vs results, history, and even a little elementary chemistry. The students will have the opportunity to create suncatchers, jewelry parts, coasters and a windchime, as well as a few small dishes.

Instructor Trish Culbert- as a neighborhood artist, I started my business 10 years ago, but have been working with glass for nearly 20 years. I create festive and functional glass dishes and participate in local juried crafts shows, including the Montclair Art Festival. For the last few years I have been teaching small workshops from my studio and have now started teaching children as well.
