

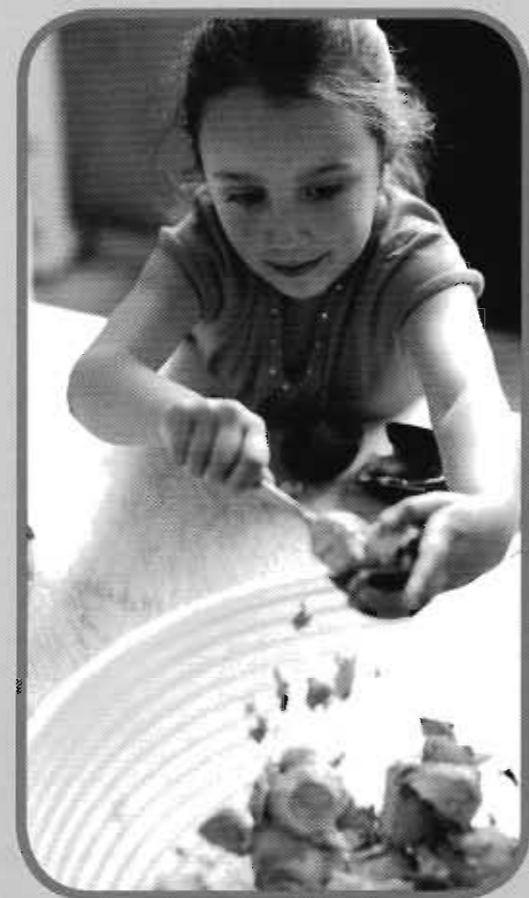

Afterschool Programs

Our afterschool programs offer structured and unstructured play and a range of enrichment classes (*Chugim*) in music, movement, cooking, drama, science, language, martial arts, and more. Kids can get help with homework or race around outdoors in the sun, fortified by healthy snacks. Older kids go off-site once a week to shoot hoops, take a hike, or participate in a partner organization's program.

Elements of Jewish tradition and culture are incorporated into the afterschool programs. On Friday afternoons we greet Shabbat with our age-appropriate Kabbalat Shabbat Program. We celebrate other Jewish holidays and cultural events, and welcome all families to join us.



Parents' Night Out

It's Saturday night and time for play-dates—for parents and kids! Parents' Night Out is held one Saturday (5:30–10 pm) a month. Kids make dinner together, play games, and watch a movie, while parents have an evening on their own. What's not to like?

Camp Tzofim

Happy campers and delighted parents agree: Camp Tzofim rocks! Open to children entering kindergarten through grade 9, the Camp provides traditional activities—swimming, talent shows, rock climbing—as well as opportunities for kids to choose music and song, drama, nature (*teva*), Judaic culture, and other programs in the afternoon.

In a quiet Oakland neighborhood surrounded by trees, parks, and acres of open space, Camp Tzofim offers kids a fog-free, high-energy way to spend part of their summer among new friends. Camp Tzofim is accredited by the American Camp Association (ACA).

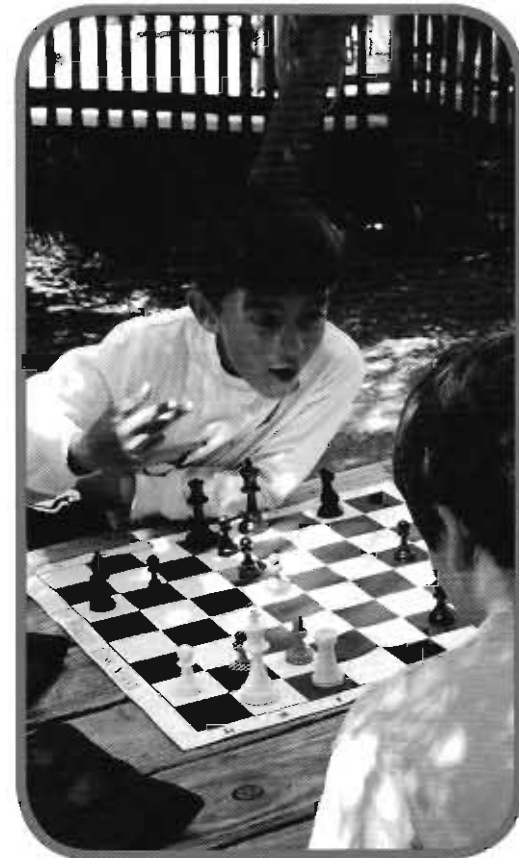


Specialty Camps
